Edward Baskerville, the son of Andrew and Mary Baskerville  
was baptized on the 5 April 1778 in the Parish Church of

BASKERVILLE Albert was baptized 20 July 1845, Stoke Lacey, Herefordshire, and died 12 June 1925, at his home Princess Rd., Claremont, Western Australia. He married

KNAPTON Eliza Ann on the 14 April 1870 at St. Mary's Church of England Busselton; the daughter of George Holland Knapton and Eliza (nee Herring). Eliza Ann was born 3 September 1851, Stepney, London, and died 13 September 1929 at her home, Princess Rd., Claremont. George Holland Knapton was a cabinet maker in England, and combined this trade in Busselton with farming at "Ellenbrook".

BASKERVILLE Harriett was born 18 September 1851 at Bunbury, and died 17 August 1892 at Bunbury, and was buried 18 August 1892 at Bunbury. She married

CAPORN Henry on the 12 January 1873 at St. Mary's Church of England, Busselton. He was a saddler, and was born in 1851 in Perth and died 17 January 1915 in Bunbury; the son of Frederick and Mary Ann (nee Clulow) Caporn, who married in 1850 in St. George's, Perth, where Frederick was a Swan River boatman, Ferryman and Pilot, Captain of the "Lady Stirling" and "Enchantress", and a Bass singer in the St. George's Church of England choir.

George Arthur Harvey, son of Edwin Harvey, was a librarian in Bunbury. There was no issue of the marriage.

Charles Henry Caporn worked for the "Western Australian Government Railways" in Geraldton at sometime, and at the time of his death, he was living in Mt. Lawley, Perth. He had no children.

BASKERVILLE Emma was born 27 November 1856 at Bunbury, and died 16 October 1916 at Busselton, and married ABBEY Thomas on the 20 March 1876 at Bunbury. He was born 28 December 1847 at Wonnerup, and died 1 May 1912 at "Newtown", the Vasse; the son of Thomas and Mary Ann (nee Minion) Abbey, who were among the first European settlers and farmers in the Vasse District.

BASKERVILLE Esther Louisa was born 22 November 1863 at Bunbury, and died sometime after 1925; and married firstly WOODROW Benjamin on the 21 March 1883 in the Congregational Church, Bunbury. He was born in 1862 in Perth, the son of Edward Josiah and Mary Ann (nee Grogan) Woodrow. Edward Josiah Woodrow was a Principal Warder at the Convict Depot's in Perth, Bunbury and York. Benjamin Woodrow worked for the "Western Australian Government Railways", and was stationed at Bunbury at the time of his death between 1911 and 1914. Esther Louisa married secondly BENNETT Walter Guy sometime between 1911 and 1917, probably in Bunbury, where he was a Carpenter.

Esther Louisa lived at Stone Street, off the Vasse Road in 1903, as did her mother. By 1911, she was still living there, although Benjamin Woodrow was not, and she was working as a Laundress. By 1917, she had married Walter Bennett, and moved to Spence Street, Bunbury, now working as a Housewife.

Esther Louisa and Benjamin Woodrow had three (known) children,

Mabel and Mary are mentioned in an Obituary notice in the "West Australian" newspaper of 20.6.1925, the notice being for Albert Baskerville. Mabel was in Perth, and Mary was in Sydney. Charles Benjamin Woodrow is not mentioned.

The "Geraldton Express and Murchison & Yalgoo Gold Fields Chronicler" newspaper of the 18.11.1904 carried a brief notice in the 'social notes' column that Cyril Frances Manuel of Adelaide married Miss M.H. Woodrow of Bunbury at the Wesleyan Church in Mingenew.
